


Course Status on Courses Home Page

If a course has never been taken, or it has been reset in order to re-take, the user's course list will show the course status as **Not started**. As soon as the user launches the course, the status will change to **In progress**.





Failed status

KNT: All of the questions were answered, and less than 80% were answered correctly.

TNG: The user has not visited 80% of the learning content. Passing is based on pages visited within the learning section, not on pre-test score.





A TNG in a failed status can be re-launched and the user may continue reviewing the learning content until a passing score is achieved. If you visit 100% of the pages, when you close the course you will receive a score of 100%. If you visit 85% of the pages, when you close the course you will receive a score of 85%. Once the passing score is recorded the course must be reset in order to receive a new score.



Knowledge tests can only be taken once. A re-take requires a reset by the Company's EnergyU Administrator. If a passed or failed test is re-launched, users will not be able to see the questions, or the question results page – they will only see the score results page.


A passing score of 80% is required for certification. You received a score of 25% on Friday, March 20, 2015.


Launching select courses

By default, the user course list does not display passed courses. In order to launch a TNG that has previously been passed, users must use the dropdown to change the display to show all or only passed courses.
